

BWFS Acoustic Coffeehouse Begins in October 2015

Our very popular Open Mic Coffeehouse begins again on **October 10 at 7:00pm**.

The Traditional Acoustic Open Mic coffeehouse series takes place monthly from October through March on the second Saturday of the Month. It begins at 7:00pm and ends at 10:00pm. It takes place at Trinity Episcopal Church, 5646 Main St., Lexington, Michigan. Admission is free to everyone but, donations are very appreciated.

Refreshments are available by donation and are provided by the Bluewater Folk Society and prepared and served by volunteers. A 50/50 Raffle is held to benefit Thumbfest and non-perishable food is collected to benefit Project Blessing.

Performers wishing to play should arrive anytime after 6:15 pm to sign up. Slots are available on a first come, first serve basis until all available slots are gone. Slots are 2 songs or 10 minutes for individual performers and 3 songs or 15 minutes for groups, whichever comes first. It is very important to adhere to these times to allow time for other performers a chance to play. The emcee for the night will set the order of play.

A complete sound system is provided with vocal and instrument microphones along with direct boxes. The only thing you need to bring is your acoustic instruments and a few songs to play.

Some BWFS History

The Blue Water Folk Society, is an ALL volunteer, 501c3 nonprofit organization founded in 2001, is dedicated to promoting and sponsoring traditional and acoustic music events in the Thumb area of Michigan.

Our original Board included President George Stewart, Treasurer Tom Schlichting, Secretary Shirley Barnett, Trustee Maggie Ewalt and Trustee Mike Tremblay.

Current Board members include President Ruth Habalewsky, Treasurer Jerry Huff, Secretary Barbara Ernsberger, Trustee Dale George, Trustee Tom Schlichting, Trustee Marty Malek and Trustee Shirley Barnett.

We have sponsored a 1960's style "Coffeehouse" the second Saturday of every month from October thru March in at Trinity Episcopal Church in Lexington since January 2001.

We also sponsor or provide music for various music events in Michigan's "Thumb Area" throughout the year and for the Sanilac County Taste of the Thumb since 2009.

Our main event is an annual festival held on the Saturday of Labor Day weekend called "Thumbfest".

The first Thumbfest was in 2002 at Camp Ozanam and it moved to downtown Lexington, Mi. in 2005. In 2005 Thumbfest featured multiple stages, a dance hall, jam Sites, workshops, crafts and more.

Thumbfest now takes place on the shores of Lake Huron in downtown Lexington and changes each year. At the present time, it is a FREE event that could only happen because of our dedicated volunteers, donations from the community, numerous fundraisers and the talents of many generous musicians. We do it for the love of the music. Volunteers are always needed.
