

- There is a **free shuttle for your use**.. the shuttle will also run to the parking lots ...you can also flag it down if needed. (Yes...we pay to rent the shuttle)
- Visit the Information table on Huron at their NEW location on Huron across from the Harborview Plaza for Thumbfest schedules & maps, Guitar Giveaway applications,T-shirt sales & pick-up, sign up for our newsletter mailing list and membership information.
- Guitar for Kids Giveaway applications for kids 7 to 17 yrs. old are ONLY at the Information table.
- Visit the CD table at the Harbor for CD sales, T-shirt sales, 50/50 raffle tickets and Thumbfest schedules and maps.
- You can find information on the boards at each stage.
- There are food vendors at the harbor this year (yeah!) and there are many restaurants in town you can visit. You can also bring your own food if you want.
- Many of our sponsors and advertisers have food including the Lexington Brewing Co. Windjammers, Celtic Ray Public House, Steis's Village Inn, Irish Rose Gift & Travel Woolen Shoppe, Foley's Market,

- Stay for the Hootenanny at the end of Thumbfest featuring many of the scheduled musicians....Sing along!
- Porta-johns are located around town as well as indoor restrooms. See the Map in the Tri-fold or ask at the information tables for locations.
- Call 911 for emergency calls. The Welcome Center is on M-25 south of the traffic light and has Village information and restrooms.
- ATMs are available at Talmer Bank and Eastern Michigan Bank on M-25.

Thumbfest 2014 Update by Mike Mercatante

I'm sitting on my front porch on a beautiful summer night as I write this article. The Tigers have just swept the Rockies. The sounds of late summer are all around me and I'm thinking that one of the most exciting sounds of summer will be heard in less than four weeks. On Saturday Aug. 30th from 10 a.m. – 10 p.m. in Lexington, the 13th annual Thumbfest acoustic music festival begins and we here at the Blue Water Folk Society are in high gear to make this the best festival ever.

Check it out. There will be 50 different acts appearing at 11 venues throughout Lexington. Add to that two additional workshop presenters and we have 52 different artists to view. That's the most acts for any Thumbfest! There will be music, storytelling and activities to please everybody.

How about an 11 piece folk orchestra that mix-matches folk, rock, zydeco, calypso, klezmer, ragtime, and Bourbon Street swing? Why that would be seven time winner for Best Folk/Acoustic Band in Detroit called The Luddites! Acoustic swing ala the Hot Club? Make sure you see the **Appleseed Collective**. You want classical, jazz, and Celtic influences with accents of world music and soul, don't miss the Thumbfest debut of **Nessa!** You want New Orleans brass party music? Welcome back the Nicky Boy Street Band! Multiple award winning Americana? Check out Stella!, and Jo Serrapere and the Willie **Dunns!** Celtic and Irish influenced music? Check out Finvarra's Wren, Kitty Donohoe and Ourselves! Cajun music? We welcome back Sel de Terre! French-Indian music? Don't miss Le Compagnie! Looking for traditional and modern Bluegrass? Check out Michigan festival favorite the Blue Water Ramblers, or the hot newgrass style picking of The Whistlestop Revue (making their Thumbfest debut), along with Black River Bluegrass Boys and The Waynewood Boys! The bluegrass jam should be smokin'. Want the real acoustic blues? Don't miss award winning Carl Henry! Classical and fingerstyle guitar to blow you away? Check out 2013 Fretboard Festival Winner **David Youngman** or 2009 Gamble Rogers Fingerpicking champion William Henry Russell! All these and so much more. Whew.

I'm also pleased to announce the return of

the Oldford Marina Open Mic Stage. It will be down by the marina and will be on a first come, first served basis. So, if you have a few tunes that you'd like to play, bring your instrument or voice and sign up and play your songs. It's a lot of fun.

We will also be having workshops and jam sites again. Be sure to bring your instrument/voice and jam or get a lesson from many of the Thumbfest performers. If you don't play, you are welcome to attend and listen and enjoy. The more the merrier!

The Thumbfest festival is an all-around family friendly event but this year we have a dedicated area for kids. Come see the various musical, story-telling, and mime/juggling performances at the Cadillac House Family Area down by the beach. Lots of fun!
