Open Mic Coffeehouse Series Going Well!

Our very popular Acoustic Open Mic Coffeehouse has two more dates on Saturday, Feb. 9 & March 9 at the Trinity Episcopal Church Hall, 5646 Main St. (M-25) in Lexington, Michigan under the direction of Dawn Malek, the Coffeehouse Director.

Dawn reports that attendance has been up this season with 90 to 110 people each month in the audience.

The Open Mics will begin at 7:00 pm and end by 10:00 pm but if you want to perform, you should be there to sign-up for a performance slot which is scheduled to begin by 6:30 pm. Sign-up will continue until all slots are filled and they have been filling early this season.

A solo performance slot will be allowed no more than 2 songs or 10 minutes, while the band slots will allow 3 songs or 15 minutes. Be ready to play when it is your turn as excessive set up time will be deducted from your performance time that you are allowed.

The emcee for the night has the right to adjust the show or time allowed to fit the time constraints. Emcees for the season have been Carol Roberts, Dean Barnett, Shirley Barnett & Bruce Filbeck. February emcee will be Jim Williams.

Tom Schlichting, Dean Barnett, Mike Mercatante & John Broadwell have been handling set-up, tear-down & sound, Dawn & Marty Malek are the all important kitchen staff and Ruth Habalewsky has handled the 50/50 Raffle. New this season has been a greeter, with Mike McCarthy filling that role in December.

The 50/50 Fundraiser Raffle with tickets at \$1 each or 6 for \$5 to support Thumbfest has raised \$427 for Thumbfest so far. Winners have been Dave Bailey (donated his \$74.50 back),

Bob Michelen, Mary Spencer (donated \$20 back) and Malcolm Lee.

Although we have no cover charge, we continue to collect canned goods for *Project Blessing* at the Church. We will also happily accept and need your financial and/or goodie donations for our refreshment table at the Coffeehouse. Remember: your contributions directly affect the quantity and quality of the refreshments we serve!
