The BWFS Annual Meeting and Election was held on June 17, at Trinity Episcopal Church, 5646 Main Street, Lexington, Michigan, 48450.

To run for office you had to be a BWFS current member for 6 months prior to the date of the meeting.

There were two candidates on the ballot for early voting and one nomination of Gordon MacDonald at the meeting.

Elected were Barb Ernsberger and John Broadwell to another term as trustee. Their terms will expire in June 2020. Elected as officers for the year were Tom Schlichting, President; Leigh Marciniak, Secretary and Shirley Barnett, Treasurer. Other members of the Board include Al Lewandowski, Mary Malek, Barb Ernsberger and John Broadwell.

Admission \$10, \$5 students, children 12 and under free. Proceeds benefit the Sanilac County Historical Society. Be there or be square!
