It's time again for the Blue Water Folk Society Annual Meeting, which will be held at Marty & Ruth Habalewsky's home at 2848 Monticello, Port Huron on June 23, 2013 at 6:30pm.

Each year, as a 501c3 organization, there are a few requirements we must meet. One of these is having an annual meeting. We need a quorum of all members and since we now have 107 members, that means we need 22 people in attendance. Attendance can be either in person or by proxy, which means you can just let us know you're with us in spirit, if not in person. Two board positions are opening. Tom Schlichting, one of the founding members of the Blue Water Folk Society, is stepping down; and Ruth Habalewsky's position is up for election. This means we need nominations for these two positions. If you would like to run for a board position, you must be a current member of the Blue Water Folk Society - if you'd like to run,

Thumbfest planning meeting as soon as we adjourn the annual meeting. It's two, two meetings in one!

Thumbfest 2013 Update by Mike Mercatante

I'm writing this on a brilliant sunshiny May 25th morning and it is thirty degrees outside. Brrrr. Michigan weather. Will it ever warm up? Well, I know one day when things will be hot. That's Saturday August 31 from 10 am-10pm in the beautiful port city of Lexington. That's the day the BlueWater Folk Society presents Thumbfest 2013, the Thumb area's premier acoustic music festival.

Thumbfest 2013 is the Blue Water Folk Society's twelfth festival and it promises to be the best one yet. There are 48 different acts booked over seven performance sites. Add to that number, a jam site, two workshop tents, and an open mic stage (new this year!), and you have a total of 11 locations in which you can indulge in the musical pleasures of your choice.

I am excited about the new performers this year. New to the festival will be The Appleseed Collective, a swinging Americana band from Ann Arbor with a lot of energy. There will also be the low-down Delta blues sounds of Shari Kane and Dave Steele. A last minute addition is award-winning Thumb native Julianne Ankley who will be bringing her country inflected music to Thumbfest for the first time. You will also enjoy the beautiful harmonies and great songwriting of the all-female group Stella! They will make your ears sigh. I'm excited about the bluegrass sounds of the Wayneboro Boys. Couple them with the Black River Bluegrass Boys and the bluegrass jam sounds like it will be really happening this year. There will be the high lonesome sound of Rocky Top, a local husband-wife duo that really hits the old-timey music of the hills with spot on accuracy. Emily Lewandowski, a young lady who has frequented the jam sessions for years, will be dazzling us with her classical influenced music in her own set. Your favorite acts from Thumbfests

past? There will be lots to choose from.

I'm pumped that the world music sounds of the Red Sea Pedestrians will be returning. The happy and joyous New Orleans brass sounds of Nicky Boy Street Band will be back and getting everyone on their feet and dancing. The high energy Celtic influenced sounds of Ann Arbor's Dragon Wagon will return. Award winners Jo Serrapere and the Willie Dunns will be back with their bluesy, atmospheric music. There will be the infectious Cajun/Creole music of Creole du Nord. Irish influenced folk singer Kitty Donahoe returns. Don't miss her. Multiple music award winners Billy Brandt and Sarana Ver Lin will be back. Folk favorites Mustard's Retreat will return to share their talents. Western swing? Try Cornpone out for a good time. Floyd King and the Bushwackers will dazzle you with their harmonies and fun show. So much to choose from.

Thumbfest has always promoted local talent as well. Catch Thumb area musicians like Lost Cuzzins, Ourselves, Still Running, William Henry Russell, Butterhair and many more at any of the stages throughout town.

As the Artistic Director for Thumbfest these past four years, it's been my privilege to work with so many talented musicians and dedicated volunteers. There is always room for more volunteers and if you'd like to help out, even for just an hour or two, please contact Thumbfest Volunteer Coordinator Ruth Habalewsky. It's a wonderful chance to participate in great day of music and fun. I hope you all have a summer filled with sun and fun and I look forward to seeing you at Thumbfest on Saturday August 31, from 10-10 in Lexington. Join us for the fun!
