Nominees run for a board position. The newly elected board will then elect their officers at a board meeting. There are two board positions are up for election. The term will run for three years, expiring at the June 2017

At the current time there are three nominees for the two positions:Carl Kammer, Barbara Ernsberger and Dale George have been active volunteers and are members of the Blue Water Folk Society.

A ballot with the nominees will be mailed on June 19 either by email or mail. Also on the ballot will be at least one by-law amendment

The election procedure will be explained when the ballot is released on June 19.



All the acts are booked and now it's time to schedule them so the festival flows. Scheduling is a rather complicated affair but I like doing it. It's like sequencing a great mix tape. It's also a challenge because several performers play in different acts and trying to keep the acts from overlapping can sometimes be a challenge. We have many really talented musicians but even Mozart couldn't be in two places at once.

Thumbfest 2014 will also have an enhanced family area with music and activities near the beach and the Harbor Stage.
