### Gathering of Friends Concert Fundraiser Al Lewandowski

On October 15<sup>th</sup> the Blue Water Folk Society sponsored the first Gathering of Friends concert at the Trinity Episcopal Church in Lexington – the home of the BWFS Coffee House. The Gathering brought together musicians from the Atlantic coast, and Western Michigan who had never played in this area together with several local musicians to play collaboratively as a group. The unusual format also provided plenty of opportunity for audience participation.

The two hour show consisted of the musicians taking turns performing solo songs and group songs involving the other players and the audience. Each of the two sets was proceeded by an opening set by a local musicians.

### Guitars for Kids Winner 2017 Shirley Barnett

The Blue Water Folk Society is pleased to announce that they gave away a total of twenty instruments which included fourteen guitars and six ukuleles at Thumbfest 2107 on September 2, 2017 to youth from 10 years to 17 years old. This was made possible by grants from the Community Foundation of St. Clair County, Sanilac County Community Foundation and the DTE Foundation plus the generosity of donors of cash and instruments. Chef Shell's Restaurant and Catering was the tent sponsor in 2017.
